CODE ENFORCEMENT ALERTS

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT:

The City of Crystal City Code Enforcement Office is responsible for but is not limited to the following:

- Issues permits for buildings, plumbing, heating and air conditioning and electrical construction (new and remodeled);
- Inspects new and remodeled work in progress to insure that building code requirements are being met with regard to building construction, plumbing, electrical, framing, foundation, heating and air conditioning;
- Inspects public buildings at least three times each year to detect any potentially dangerous fire hazards;
- Inspects buildings occupied by businesses at least twice each year to detect any potential dangerous fire hazards.

The City of Crystal City Code Enforcement Office will strictly enforce the following, if you have any questions please call the City Hall at (830) 374-3477 or Mr. Ismael Cabello at (830) 448-7220:

1. Vehicles parked on the Right of Way will be ticketed and/or removed at owner's expense.
2. Signs on trees, on any posts or on any street, alley or side walk will be pulled and warning will be issued.
3. Citizens will be notified if they have stray or loose dogs with a warning, if they do not become in compliance, they will then be ticketed and/or cited to appear before the municipal judge.
4. When individuals have high grass, weeds and/or brush blocking the view of oncoming traffic, a notice will be sent out giving a warning, if there is no compliance a citation will be given from \$200.00 to \$2000.00
5. RV's are illegal to have in your property. A call must be placed to the City for permission in order to have the RV parked there as long as no one lives in them.
6. Prohibited Animals in the City Limits: Horses, Cattle, Goats and Pigs.
7. Manufactured homes: Before you buy one, you must first bring in four pictures of the home and it must be dated 1993 or newer.
8. Dog limits on property will be monitored as the limit per household is three.
9. Junk cars on yard will be monitored with a warning and followed by a ticket.
10. Illegal dumping of trash in the city dumpsters within the city limits will be strictly punishable by fines, please utilize the landfill.
11. Food stands and/or people who sell food cannot operate in residential areas or in your home without a permit. This is being monitored; you will first be given a warning, if there is no compliance it will be followed by a citation.
